No. FRW. 55/86/64.—In exercise of powers conferred by Section 35 of "The wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972," The Governor of Assam is pleased to declare the area included within the limits of the boundaries described in the 'Schedule A' below to be a National Park with effect from the date of publication of this Notification.

DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARIES

North—From the Point where the Sukanian River crosses Indo-Bhutan Boundary at B. P. No. 192/3 the Northern Boundary runs along the Indo-Bhutan Boundary eastwards upto the point where the Potanadi (Agarbari) river crosses the Indo-Bhutan Boundary at B. P. N. No 220.

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East—From the point of Indo-Bhutan Boundary Piller No. 220 along the left bank of Potundi (Agbari) river towards South to a point where it meets the Southern Boundary of the Koklabari R. F. (Addition) Thence along the old Southern Boundary road of Koklabari R. F. (Addition) Westwards to a point where it meets Randhani Baudhani stream (about 0.8 km.) below Koklabari camp and thence along the old Boundary of N. K. RF (Addition) at bearing of 267° for a distance of 1320.00 m. to B. P. No. 1

From B. P. No. 23 the Boundary line runs in the Western direction to B. P. No. 24 at a bearing of 274° for a distance of 1540.00 M. along the Northern Boundary of Agrong Forest Village in a close proximity of Betbari Camp. Thence to B. P. No-25 at a bearing of 166° for a distance of 2400.00 M. where meets the old Southern Boundary road of N. K. R. F. (addition) near Khoirabari Forest Camp.

South.—From the terminating point of the Eastern Boundary it runs along the old agrong Bhuyapara road-South Boundary road of N. K. RF. (addition) to Bhuyapara Range office. Thence along the old Southern Boundary road of N. K. RF. touching at Katajhar Beat and Bhatgali Beat office and going further West upto the Eastern Boundary of Kahitama RF. Thence along the left bank of Mora Manas where it meets the Southern Boundary of Kahitama RF. and crosses Mora Manas. Thence along the old Southern Boundary road of Kahitama RF. Thence it crosses the Jia Manas (Hakua) and runs along the Eastern Boundary of Panbari R. F. where it meets the Southern Boundary of Panbari R. F. Thence along the South Boundary of Panbari R. F. and thence along the Western Boundary of Panbari R. F. to a point on the left bank of Burisuta river.

West—Thence along the left bank of Burisuta river and thence along the right bank of Sukanjan river to the Starting point on the Indo-Bhutan B. P. No. 192/3.
