No. FRW. 25/2008/36 : In exercise of the powers conferred under the sub-section (1) of section 38(V) of the Wild Life (Protection) Act 1972 (Central Act 53 of 1972) the Governor of Assam on the recommendation of Tiger Conservation Authority hereby declares that the area, the boundaries which are specified in the schedule below, as a tiger reserve.

Wildlife Sanctuary along with the reserved forests of Kachugaon, Haltugaon, Chirang and Dhansiri Territorial divisions of BUDDLAND TERRITORIAL AREAS DISTRICT AREA along Indo-Bhutan International boundary.

The Name of the Districts : Kokrajhar, Chirang, Baga and Udalguri.

Forest Division(s) : Manas National Park, Orang Wildlife Division, Dhansiri Division, Kachugaon Division, Haltugaon Division and Chirang Division.
